3 minor boys among five of family killed in Pak shelling

Five members of a family, including three minor children, were killed and two others injured as Pakistani troops resorted to "unprovoked and indiscriminate" shelling in over half-a-dozen villages near the Line of Control in Balakote sector, in Poonch district, on Sunday morning. The victims have been identified as Mohammad Ramzan(35), wife Malika Bi(32), sons Mohammad Rehman (14), Mohammad Rizwan (12), and Razaq Ramzan (7), Ramzan's two daughters, Nasreen Kousar (11), and Mahreen Kousar(5) are reported to have suffered serious injuries.

Sources said the victims were inside their house, in Devta Sargloon village, when a mortar shell fell on their roof, Nasreen and Mahreen were airlifted to Jammu, where they are undergoing treatment at the Gov. Medical College Hospital.

A defence Ministry spokesperson, Lt. Colonel D. Anand said the Pakistani Army initiated unprovoked and indiscriminate firing of 81 mm and 120 mm mortar shells, besides other small arms fire, in Balkote area, from 7.45 am to 11.30 am on Sunday. He said they targeted innocent civilians, their homes and livestock in villages close to the LoC.

"In today's ceasefire violation, an issue of serious concern has been that Pakistan is targeting innocent civilians in localities deep inside Indian territory, almost 3-4 km from the LoC, where there is no Army deployment or any installation or even equipment installed." He said.
